Teams will be judged on the following scale, and must show a minimum of 50 ewes.

Wool quantity for type	50 points
Wool quality and character	50 points
Conformation and size	30 points
Trueness to type	35 points
Uniformity	25 points
Presentation	25 points
Culling percentage	25 points
Total	250 points
