Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Beef Cattle Judging Competition - Rules and Regulations

- 1 Competitors must be over 15 and under 25 years of age on 1 May in the year of the State Final at the Royal Easter Show.
- 2 Competitors can compete in only one Group Final but it is not necessary to reside within the boundaries of the Group conducting the Final.
- 3 No competitor can represent more than one show society in any one Group Final and no more than one group in a State Final. The winners of a National Final cannot compete at any level in the particular competition that they won.
- 4 Winners of two (2) State Finals in any one class shall not be eligible for future competitions in that class.
- 5 The Hormel Slide is to be used at all Group and State Finals.
- 6 Groups are entitled to be represented at State level by two (2) competitors unless otherwise stated.
- 7 Group Secretaries must inform the ASC of the name, date of birth, address and telephone number of any competitor in judging competitions going on to State Finals. The ASC will advise these competitors of the venue and times of the State Final. In addition, a complete list of all competitors in a

Group Final must be sent to the ASC the next working day after the competition.

- 8 Winners should be requested to do a report on any study tour they take as a result of winning a competition to justify the sponsorship money.
- 9 Competitors will be eliminated from the competition if deemed by the chief steward to be receiving outside assistance.

Purebred Classes

- A. Heifer showing no more than 2 permanent teeth
- B. Cow showing no more than 4 permanent teeth with her calf – calf to be under 12 months (Crossbred calf accepted)
- C. Cow with her calf – calf to be under 12 months (Crossbred calf accepted)
- 1 **Champion Female** – each breed
- 2 **Champion Heifer** – all breeds (purebred)
- 3 **Champion Commercial Female** – (purebred)

Crossbred Classes

- D. Crossbred heifer showing no more than 2 permanent teeth
- E. Crossbred cow with her calf – calf to be under 12 months
- 4 **Champion Crossbred Female**
- 5 **Grand Champion Commercial Female** – purebred / crossbred
- 6 **Commercial Group** – consisting of both a Class A heifer and a cow and calf drawn from class B or C representing one breed owned by exhibitor
- 7 **Lake Edward Trophy** – the female with the greatest capacity to convert grass to beef (drawn from both commercial and prime vealer cattle classes); the winner should be the cow with the highest percentage of her bodyweight in sucking calf weight (under 12 months); signs of closeness to calving is a bonus

Stud Cattle and Led Steer Section Sunday 12 February 2012

Registered Stud Beef Cattle

- To be on showground by 8:30 am Sunday
- Cattle to be judged at 9:00 am
- Birth dates are taken from 1 March
- Animals are only eligible to compete in 1 class
- Ribbon winners to be led in parade if required
- Steers that competed in Saturday's Prime Cattle Section are NOT eligible to compete in the led steers
- All animals to have a nose lead in at all times when being led, bulls over the age of 12 months must have a nose ring.
- No bulls to be led by a parader under the age of 16
- All exhibits to remain on the ground until 4pm on the day of exhibition
- Entry Fee: \$5.00 per exhibit; school entries free, all classes
- 1st and 2nd ribbons in all classes

Beef Cattle Paraders Competition Rules and Regulations

- 1 Competitors must be 13 years and under 19 years of age on 1 May in the year of the State Final at the Royal Easter Show.
- 2 Competitors qualify via ASC Group Finals to be conducted during the previous 12 months.
- 3 To be eligible to compete for Group Finals, competitors can compete in only one Group Final but it is not necessary to reside within the boundaries of the Group conducting the Final.
- 4 Each Group Final will be allowed to select from 3 to 10 Finalists, depending on the number of entrants in the Group Final, to represent that Group at the State Final held at the following Royal Easter Show.
- 5 Individual ASC Groups will determine where Group Finals will be held.
- 6 Group Secretaries must inform the ASC of the name, address, telephone number and age of Finalists and a list of all who competed in the Group Final as soon as possible so as to check on competitors competing in more than one Final.
- 7 Winners should be requested to do a report on any study tour they take as a result of winning a competition to justify the sponsorship money.
- 8 Rules/Regulations to be sent out to State Finalists.

- All paraders will need to complete an indemnity waiver form which must be signed by parent or guardian and submitted on entry
