OPENING HOURS: Saturday, 10 February 9am - late & Sunday, 11 February 9am-5pm
Entrance via East Street, Crookwell



TICKETS: Pre-purchase tickets online at crookwellshow.com.au or buy at the gate.

DRIVING: Parking is free at Todkill Park; remember, entry to the Show is via the East Street gate.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT: A free bus service is picking up around Crookwell via the Spring Street bus stop and the Todkill Park car park to the Ydinya Bar. This service operates in both directions. Contact Skelly's Bus Service on 0428 225 720 or Wendy Skelly on 0428 321 178 for bookings.

AROUND THE SHOW: Free dual-seat RTV carts are available for easy transport around the Show. Contact Scott Milner on 0439 465 754 or the Show office for bookings.

DINING: At the Main Pavilion there are sandwiches, slices, tea and coffee, cold drinks and sweets on the menu. If you prefer a BBQ, visit the St Mary's Primary School BBQ firing up under the oak trees. They will be serving egg and bacon rolls, steak and onion sandwiches, and sausage sandwiches.

ATM: An ATM is near the Office, and Eftpos is available at the Main gate and Ydinya Bar.
